Obituary of Richard Bair

Richard Eugene "Dick" Bair, 85, of Fruitland Park, Florida, died Sunday, July 17, 2011. Born in Mt. Vernon, Ohio, he moved to Leesburg in 1951. He attended Ohio State University. He was an Air Force veteran of World War II and the Korean War. He was president and director of W.B.B. Development, Inc. He was Executive Vice President of Mason's Concrete of Leesburg and Crystal River, Cummer Inc. of Ocala, Atlas Concrete and Lynne Precast for 26 years. He served on the board of the Florida Concrete Products Association. He was Past President of the Leesburg Chamber of Commerce and Leesburg Jr. Chamber of Commerce, first recipient of the Everett Boyd Distinguished Service Award, past Commodore of the Leesburg Boating Club and served on the committees to establish the Leesburg Hospital and Lake-Sumter Jr. College. He was also a 26 year member of the Leesburg Sunrise Rotary Club. He was past deacon of the First Presbyterian Church of Leesburg and a member of North Lake Presbyterian Church. He was a fifty year member of the Masonic Mt. Zion Lodge No. 9 in Mt. Vernon, Ohio.

Richard is survived by his wife, Molly W. Bair of Fruitland Park, FL; sons, Craig A. Bair of Sanford, FL, R. Stanley Bair of Fruitland Park, FL; daughter, B. Diane Hall of Orlando, FL; brother, Ross A. Bair of Andrews, NC, sister,

Margene Weber of Oceanside, CA; five grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
