Richard Curreri, beloved father, grandfather, brother, uncle and friend, passed away on November 30, 2024, in Lady Lake, Florida. Born on February 9, 1947, in Quincy, Massachusetts to the late Leonard Curreri and Josephine Curreri (Licata), Richard exemplified reserved strength and unwavering duty throughout his life.

Richard proudly served his country as a Staff Sergeant in the United States Air Force assigned to the 3630 Flight Training Wing.
