Obituary of Richard Janssen

Richard (Dick) Janssen passed away on April 26, 2015, at the age of 69 in an Orlando, Florida area hospital after a lengthy illness. He was born in Marshall, Minnesota on April 11, 1946 to Peter and Mary (DeSutter) Janssen. Dick attended elementary schools in Minnesota and Ghent and is a 1964 graduate of Central Catholic High School in Marshall and Humboldt Airline Institute in Minneapolis.
