Obituary of Richard Pfahler

Richard Norman "Dick" Pfahler, 85, of Leesburg, Florida, died Sunday, September 20, 2015 at Leesburg, Florida. Born October 3, 1929 in Mansfield, Ohio, Dick moved to Leesburg in 1939 and graduated from Leesburg High School in 1948. He served 26 years in the US Navy and later worked in food production as an engineer at Golden Gem in Umatilla. He was a lifetime member of the Military Officer's Association, a member of Fleet Reserve, American Legion, Korean War Vets Chapter 169, and the Knights of Columbus. Dick was a very active member of the Catholic Community of St. Paul, Leesburg, FL. He is survived by his wife, Vi Pfahler of Leesburg, FL; children, Joseph (Lori) Pfahler of Pennsylvania, Marie Leggett of Ocala, FL, and Jimmy (Tina) Pfahler of Mississippi; 6 grandchildren; and 5 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Gertrude Pfahler; his parents William Pfahler and Mae Frisch; a great grandchild; and his brother Robert.
