Obituary of Richard Register

Richard L. Register, 78 of Fruitland Park died on Wednesday, October 28, 2009. He was born October 28, 1931 in Clearwater, FL and moved to Lady Lake from Leesburg in 1966, then later to Fruitland Park. He was co-owner and operator of Quick Shop Food Store and Richard's Hardware in Lady Lake for 28 years. He was a US Army Veteran of the Korean War. He built his own acrobatic airplane named "Christian Eagle." He flew his plane for 4 years and was a pilot for 14 years. He was a member of the Harley Davidson Dresser Club and enjoyed motor home traveling and camping.

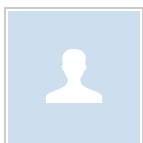
