Obituary of RICHARD WERTH

Richard Thomas Werth, 86, of Altoona passed away Monday, April 15, 2013. He was born May 9, 1926, in Green Bay, Wisconsin, the son of Henry and Grace Brazeau Werth. He served with the U.S. Army 5th Armored Division in World War II. After the war, he accepted civilian employment with the military government, Political Intelligence Division, in Wuerttemberg/Baden, Germany. He was graduated from St. Norbert's College, De Pere, Wisconsin in 1951. He joined Borg Warner International Division in Chicago in 1964 where he met his future wife, Dorothy Carll. After 34 years with Borg Warner, they retired to Ocala, Florida, in 1990. Ten years later he moved to the Lakeview Terrace retirement community in Altoona. He was an active, lifelong Republican who served as state convention delegate in Illinois and Florida and co-founded a Republican Club in Marion County, Florida. Richard was an avid philatelist and computer enthusiast. He is survived by his wife, Dorothy Carll Werth and many cousins and friends. He was a devout member of the Catholic Church. A memorial service will be celebrated on Tuesday, April 23 at 9:30 a.m. at St. Mary of the Lakes Catholic Church, Eustis. Interment will be at Florida National Cemetery, Bushnell, Florida. In lieu of flowers, contributions may be made to the Humane Society of Lake County.
