



Robert Samuel Blumberg

May 6, 1929 - December 27, 2020

Robert Samuel "Bob" Blumberg of The Villages, Florida passed away Sunday, December 27, 2020, at the age of 91. After waging a valiant battle against COPD, he died peacefully at home.

Bob was born in Brooklyn, New York to father, Louis Blumberg, and mother, Gertrude Blumberg. The oldest of three sons, he spent most of his youth in the Five Towns area of Long Island and attended high school at Bordentown Military Institute in New Jersey, where he was a ranked junior amateur tennis player. A graduate of Nichols College, he enjoyed a successful professional managerial career in New York City before relocating his family to Fort Lauderdale in the early 1970s and launching his own commercial design firm, in which he served as the principal for the next four decades.

A man with varied talents and interests, Bob was equally adept on the golf course, at the potter's wheel, behind a painter's easel and as a valued member of The Villages Architectural Review Board.

Bob is survived by his loving wife of 69 years, Molla "Mikki" Blumberg; children Dr. Stephen Blumberg (Dr. Gabriele Blumberg), Jayne Cande (Kevin), Amie (George) Ruthauser and Jeffrey (Libby) Blumberg; grandchildren Kirsten Blumberg, Erik Blumberg (Victoria Smith), Jill Ruthauser and Emma Blumberg; and great-grandchild Matteo Cande Boch.
