Obituary of Robert Caldwell

Robert (Bob) Eugene Caldwell was born in Alden, Kansas on June 2, 1924 to Fred and Mabel Caldwell and went home to be with the Lord on June 2, 2015 at the age of 91. He was preceded in death by his parents, brother, Bill Caldwell and sister, Phyllis Rainbolt.

A loving and beloved husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather .He leaves a grateful and loving family: wife Reola, daughter Pamela Gillmore, son Randy Caldwell daughter-in-law Mary Caldwell plus three grandchildren (Jeff, Britni and Kendra) and 11 great-grandchildren.

He joined the Marines on July 10, 1944 and was released with an Honorable discharge on May 7, 1946. Serving in WWII in Guam, Marshall Islands, Solomon Islands and Tianjin, China. Bob retired from the Santa Fe Railroad after a fulfilling railroad career of 43 years. He began his railroad career as a telegraph operator and held various progressive assignments in Kansas, Oklahoma and Texas. After retirement from the railroad Bob and Reola travelled the United States for 10 years in their motor home enjoying many sites across the states. In 1996, Bob and Reola settled down in Clermont, Florida where he and Reola have lived for the past 17 years, joining the Unity

Church in Orlando, Florida. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge and Karem Shriners in Waco, Texas.
