Obituary of Robert Dean

Robert P. Dean, 88, resident of The Villages, FL, passed away on January 18, 2017. Known to everyone as Bob, he was the oldest of the six children of Francis "Frank" and Frances Dean. Along with his parents he was predeceased by his brother, Frederick and his sisters, Marjorie Trujillo and Patricia Ross. He is survived by his wife of 56 years, Mary; his children, Francis Dean and Kerry Dean Carso; grandchildren, Jackson and Madeline Dean and Owen and Nathaniel Carso; his sisters, Martha Patz and Mary Mitcheson. He is also survived by many nieces, nephews, grandnieces, and grandnephews. He was born in Everett, Massachusetts, graduated from Everett High School in 1947, and was an active member of the Everett community for many years. He served as president of the city's Lions Club, was a long-time member of the Elks Lodge, and was chairman of the Everett Conservation Commission. Bob was a fan of the New England Patriots and attended every home game from the team's inception in 1960 through 1985. For many years he was Executive Vice President of Radio Component Corporation in Lynn, Massachusetts, retiring in 1988. In 1997 he and Mary started spending winters at The Villages and moved in year-round in 2001. During his retirement, Bob enjoyed playing golf and bocce. He also traveled extensively, visiting Europe, taking cruises of the Caribbean, and touring many areas in the United States.
