



Robert Neal Doremus

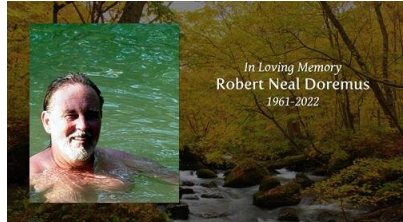
April 28, 1961 - August 22, 2022
