Robert M Eisenberg of "The Villages", FL, born Jan 14, 1926, Altoona Pa., passed away February 25, 2015. He was preceded by wife Agnes Inez, father Leander and mother Goldie Eisenberg. Bob served in the Army WW II with the Communications Corp. He was a long time Villages resident -over 20 years. In addition to enjoying many of The Villages amenities, Bob and his beloved wife Agnes, took numerous trips throughout the world.

He was a senior systems design engineer and manager with ERCO, ACF, and Link Division of Singer located in Riverdale and Silver Springs, Maryland for over 40 years and traveled extensively supporting simulators in the U.S. and Europe. During that time he was awarded 15 patents for unique designs in radar and flight simulation. He was also an FCC registered amateur radio operator -W3LMJ and a founding member of the Knights, a Villages Social golfing group where Bob was known as "The Wizard".
