Colonel Robert A. Farr, Sr. 85 of Leesburg, FL passed away peacefully surrounded by family on August 23, 2018. He was born September 29, 1932 in Randolph, Vermont a son of Volney and Gladys Farr. He married his high school sweetheart Marilyn Drew in 1954.

Robert "Bob" began his military service upon entering the ROTC program at University of Vermont where he earned a bachelor's degree in agricultural science and completed his Masters of Business Administration at Syracuse University in New York.

He lived and served his entire 30 year career in the U.S. Army in various posts around the world including 2 tours in Vietnam. Prior to his retirement he served as Military Attaché to the ambassadors in Nepal and India.
