Obituary of Robert Fazekas

Robert A. "Bob" Fazekas, 51, of Yalaha, Florida was born February 18, 1960 in Hialeah, Florida and died May 13, 2011 in Tavares, Florida. He was a retired firefighter with Broward County Fire and Rescue and a responder to the Deepwater Horizon disaster in the Gulf of Mexico. Additionally, Bob taught classes at the Miami-Dade Fire College. He moved to Yalaha in 2004 from Pembroke Pines, Florida and resided there until his death. He was a member of St. Paul's Catholic Church in Leesburg, Florida, and was Past Cub Scoutmaster of Pack 213 at St Paul's. A 3rd degree Knight of Columbus, Bob served as Past Grand Knight of Council 4851 and as a State Warden.

Survivors include his wife of 16 years Carolyn, of Yalaha, FL and son Nicholas of Yalaha; step-son Christopher Anterio of Orlando, FL; mother Jean Fazekas of DeFuniak Springs, FL; brother Stephen (Sandy) Fazekas; sister Kathryn (Murray) Fazekas Brooks; nieces and nephews: Stephanie, Jennifer, Andrew, Donald and Scott; and brother in law Donald (Leisa) Burnette. He was preceded in death by his father, Stephen Fazekas, Sr.
