Obituary of Robert Goguen

Robert A. Goguen, 67, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, June 12, 2011 at his home in The Villages.

Born in Worcester, Massachusetts, Bob spent most of his life in Connecticut. He enlisted in the Connecticut Air National Guard in 1962 and traveled the world while he proudly served his country for over 40 years. In 2003, he retired with the rank of Chief Master Sergeant.

Bob and his wife, Marti McGrath, moved to The Villages from Connecticut in 2005. They happily discovered a new community and friends that were just as warm and sunny as their new Florida home. Bob loved playing golf, pickleball, and showing off his culinary skills for any family or friend who would join their dinner table.
