March 23, 1959 - January 14, 2023

Robert McKay LeBaron died at his home in Clermont, FL, on January 14, 2023, at the age of 63.

Robert was born March 23, 1959 in Ithaca NY to Homer and Venita Vance LeBaron; he was the 4th child in a family of 7 children. He spent the first year of his life in Alberta Canada and in 1960, when Rob was a year old, the family moved to Norfolk Virginia, in 1964, to Hartsdale NY, and in 1973, to Greensboro, NC.
