Robert W. Magoon, age 87. Born in Albany, CA to Eunice and Frank Magoon, died in his home with his loving wife of 42 years by his side. Capt. Bob, as he liked to be called, left behind 2 daughters, 2 sons, 2 stepsons and 8 grandchildren.

He served in the U.S. Naval Reserve assigned to the USS Philippine Sea, an aircraft carrier going to Hawaii and on to Japan and Hong Kong. After transferred to the USS Box, another aircraft carrier, specially equipped for service as The Flagship during The Nuclear Bomb testing at Bikini Atoll, Enewetak and Johnson Island there witnessed over 50 tests. Upon his return to San Diego got his discharge.

After returning to the San Francisco Bay area, went into the IBEW Electrical apprenticeship program working his way up and through to San Francisco Branch Manager and Vice President for Amelco Electric. Many projects later transferred to Hawaii to cover Pacific and Guam Operations for 10 years.

During his years, he got very involved in racing his Sailboat "Racy" up and down the West Coast and to Hawaii 2 times. After retirement, traded in his sailboat for "Matilda", a 42' Grand Bank to fulfill a dream voyage of ours to go through the Panama Canal and up the Intercoastal to New York and Canada.

Ending up in Florida with warm weather and beautiful waters was a happy place to end.
