Obituary of Robert McKenna

Robert Lawrence McKenna passed away on Monday, November 30, 2015. "Bob" was a Brooklyn guy at heart (Sheepshead Bay specifically), even though he thoroughly enjoyed his last decade or so living in Clearwater and The Villages, Florida. The son of a New York City police officer, Bob was a long-time Metropolitan Life employee retiring as a senior executive. Following retirement he filled in spare hours as a bar tender and working for HR Block filing taxes.

Bob loved the outdoors, travel, sports in general, golf in particular, driving in the car for long car rides and visiting family and friendsHe was a ham-radio operator back in the day, he served his country as part of the Air Force reserves, played darts in pubs, loved tinkering with consumer electronics, built his family a "heath-kit" television from scratch way back in 1975 and enjoyed seeing the American Southwest, especially places like New Mexico and Arizona. He even ventured up north for trekking in Alaska and jumped across the globe to Africa for enjoy some adventurous safaris and scuba diving. He loved watching the Premier League (especially the Arsenal Gunners) on TV. He coached all his kids at one point or another on their youth soccer teams...

He was a Catholic deeply grounded in faith and strong morals (he inherited this from his father, who he described "as a man of the utmost integrity"). He attended St. Augustine's High School, graduated from Baruch College in New York City. Some may say that faith is what gave him his much-needed edge in his Pickleball game - a sport he loved to participate in to stay healthy and socialize.

He'll be remembered for his kindness and compassion to others, his wisdom, his Brooklyn "regional dialect", his sense of humor and for one of his favorite aphorisms, "Good luck, bad luck, who knows"...he was a philosopher (in his own mind), a loyal son, a dedicated father, loving husband, uncle, cousin and friend. We'll miss him terribly but we will draw comfort from the fact that he'll be joining many of his loved ones in heaven.
