Robert Eugene Reber, age 83, of Leesburg, FL was born August 29, 1927 in Marilla, MI to Christian Reber and Pearl Sutherland Reber and died January 11, 2011. Bob was a graduate of Bell Center High School (Ohio), Class of 1944, and went on to serve in the US Army during the Korean Conflict and was an atomic veteran. He was a machinist for United Aircraft Products of Forest, OH. He was a Presbyterian.
