Robert J Santoro, Jr. died Thursday, April 18th, 2013. He was 76 years old. Mr. Santoro was born in Wakefield, MA. He graduated from Providence College and was a Captain in the Army. Mr. Santoro lived most of years in Stoneham, MA where he was youth hockey coach for his sons and won a National Championship with his Bantam team. He was the owner of Santoro's Sub Villa in Saugus, MA. He was an avid hunter and golfer. In his retirement Mr. Santoro moved to the Villages, FL where he was the President of the Italian American Club.
