Obituary of Robert Vignec

Robert (Bob) Wheeler Vignec, 78, beloved husband and father, died August 8, 2011.

Bob was born March 26, 1933, in Staten Island, New York. He served as a submariner in the U.S. Navy, and then worked for AT&T for 32 years. He loved spending summers with his friends at the Jersey shore, where he met his wife, Linda, to whom he was married for 44 years.
