Robin Andrew Wilhelm, (74) of Leesburg, Florida, passed away on Saturday, October 4, 2025, at UF Health Spanish Plainses Hospital. He was surrounded by his loving wife, Vickie (McClean), of 53 years, and his two children, Tracy and Spencer.

Robin was the embodiment of a calm, steady presence and possessed a gentle soul. He was well-liked by all who had the pleasure of meeting him. His unwavering patience meant he never lost his temper, a quality his family cherished deeply.

Born in Pine Bluffs, Wyoming on September 9, 1951 to Robert and Mary Lynne Wilhelm, Robin spent his early years there before his family moved to Evergreen, Colorado. It was in Evergreen that he met his high school sweetheart and future bride, Vickie. They were married in 1972 and returned to Pine Bluffs where they would build their life and family. 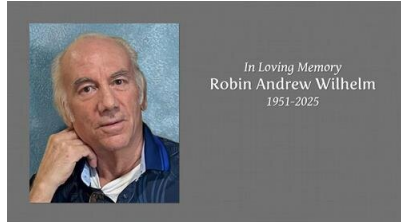
Interment of ashes and a celebration of life will be held in Pine Bluffs, Wyoming at a later date. Specific details will be shared by the family.

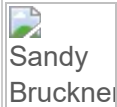
