Ronald Warren Glover was born in Camilla Georgia, November 24th, 1950. His family moved to Fruitland Park, FL when he was 3 years old. He attended Leesburg High School. A Vietnam Veteran, he joined the Army in 1967 and he was very proud of his military service, receiving a Purple Heart for injuries sustained serving his country. Upon returning from his military service, he settled in Leesburg, FL where he started work for Florida telephone in 1972 and retired from the Sprint phone company, working as a senior lineman technician.
