on a second trip to the brisbane area in 1991, a 3300-kilometer trip through the out back area was arranged by the baptist church for her to speak 31 times in 33 days.

she was invited by robert frost, director of evangelism for the united church of england to speak in each district in the kingdom a three week assignment.

became pastor at trilby umc with active membership of less than a dozen, 1984 retired in 1991, with a membership in excess of 350 and with building program of several hundred thousand dollars completely paid.

featured speaker at billy graham school of evangelism, seattle, toronto, nashville & orlando

she was active with teen missions international, led a group of 26 teens and six adults on a six weeks tour in australia to perform christian drama in brisbane public schools, over 520 professions of faith were recorded. 1989.

for aids orphans & street children she financed an orphanage that served 500 students in uganda on a daily basis; a 250 seat church with living accommodations for the pastor's family in malawi; and a dormitory for 20 girls. these were all pilot programs in africa that are continuing to expand.
