Roy Earl Hunter, Jr., 88, of Paisley, FL passed away on Monday, March 26, 2018. He was born in St. Louis, MO. He was the owner/operator of Roy Service Center in Boca Raton, FL and a member of the St. Peter's Catholic Church in Deland, FL. He was a shiner, a 3rd degree Mason (for over 50 years), and a member of the American Legion. He founded the North Lake Chamber of Commerce and helped to establish the Paisley Fire Department, the Paisley library, and the children's playground. He was the volunteer of the year for Spring Creek Charter School in Paisley, FL. He was a veteran in the United States Air Force, having served in the Korean War.

He is survived by his loving wife: Francine Hunter; son: Larry Hunter, Louisville, KY; daughters: Melanie (Chuck Meeks) Kovar, Loxahatchee, FL and Annie Heitman, Troy, MO; grandchildren: Dylan and Robert; great granddaughter: Sarah Lee; stepchildren: Mark, Carol, Louise, Lynne, JoAnne, and Luce.
