Royce Earl Seay, Sr., 83, of Bushnell passed away November 7, 2024 in Lady Lake, Florida with his loving family present. He was born in Webster on February 5th, 1941 to Leroy and Martha (Pitzer) Seay. Royce was in the Army from 1959 to 1967 where he served in Vietnam. Included with his medals were Vietnam Service Medal with 60 Device, Sharpshooter (M1 & M16), National Defense Service Medal, one overseas bar, Senior Parachutist Badge (58 jumps) as well as The Good Conduct Medal. He married Sally (Covyaw) Seay in 1962. Royce was Pentecostal. He never met a stranger and was extremely giving and loving. One of his hobbies included clogging and he belonged to Sumter County Cloggers for over 20 years. Royce also grew sugar cane and made cane syrup for over 20 years as well as enjoyed vegetable gardening. Additionally, Royce enjoyed fishing, woodworking and could build furniture for the house and children. Royce was self-employed and owned Seay's Dragline and Bulldozer Service. He dug many of the ponds in Sumter and surrounding counties. He is survived by his two daughters, Robin Seay of Bay Hill, FL, Dana Seay of Bay Hill, Florida; 7 grandchildren; Jonathan (Angie) Seay, Justin (Melinda) Marshall, Austin Marshall, Taylor Howard, Dillon Roebuck, Ethan (Lindsay) Howard and Kelsie Roebuck, 12 great grandchildren; 2 loving sisters; Joyce Mask and Shirley Bilbrey and several nieces and nephews. Royce was preceded in death by his son Royce Earl Seay, Jr., his parents Leroy and Martha Seay and sister Faye Lee Seay. 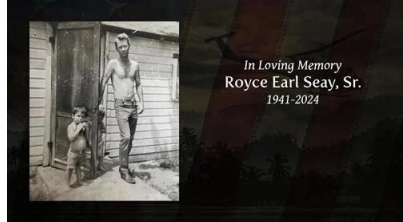
