Obituary of Rudy Baxter

Rudy Baxter, 76, of Wildwood, FL, died Wednesday, November 21, 2012 at Wildwood, FL. He was born March 6, 1936 in Clio, AL. Mr. Baxter graduated with a Master's Degree from Auburn University. He retired from the Sumter County School Board in 2003. He was a teacher at Wildwood High School, assistant principal of Wildwood High School, principal at Wildwood Middle School for 22 yrs., principal at Sumter County Adult Education, and the first principal of West Street School in Bushnell. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Wildwood.
