She was admired for her always upbeat, cheerful personality and humor. She was reluctant to ever say anything bad about anyone, rather, choosing to

She was preceded to heaven by her parents and her brother. She is survived by her husband of 63 years, Daniel Lowmaster; her daughters Phyllis Hassani of Charlotte, NC and Joy Fyock of Reynoldsville, PA; sons Jerald Lowmaster of Youngstown, OH and Scott Lowmaster of Ocala, FL; and two grandchildren, Jake and Cole Fyock.
