Obituary of Sam Alimonti

Sam A. Alimonti, age 89, of Lady Lake, Florida passed away September 17, 2011 at Corner Stone Hospice in The Villages. He was born October 7, 1921, in Town of Union, NY, the son of Joseph and Adeline DeFrancisco Alimonti, one of eight children. Mr. Alimonti moved to Lady Lake, Florida in 1986 from Hopewell Junction, NY. He was a veteran of WWII, having served in the US Army. He was retired from IBM where he was a manager in the food service area for the IBM Club, where he organized many trips and social functions. Sam was an avid golfer, and spent many wonderful hours on the golf course with his wife. He had a wonderful sense of humor, and will be missed by the wait staff at two local diners that were dear to his heart (Wolfy's and Pete's). He will also be remembered for his Easter Pie, City Chicken, and other Italian dishes that were his specialty. Sam was a member of St. Timothy Catholic Church, Lady Lake, Florida.

He is survived by his wife of 33 years, Alice B. Alimonti. He is also survived by one sister: Jenny Cecere; three daughters and one son; Bonnie Lindberg (Steven), Pamela Alimonti(Mike), Tanya DePersiis (Angelo), Jason Alimonti (Laurie); one step-daughter and two step-sons; Shirley Tanzosch, Bobby Odell (Phyllis), and David Odell (Kathy). dearly. He was pre-deceased by 3 brothers, 3 sisters, one son, Sam Alimonti, Jr., and one grandson, Billy Odell.
