Sandy Lybe, 73, of Groveland, FL passed peacefully at her home surrounded by family on November 7th 2021.

Sandy loved working with her piano and voice students and was always so proud to see them succeed. She loved singing in the church choir and going for long drives just to enjoy the scenery, but she especially loved spending time with her family. Sandy touched so many peoples lives through her passion for music and will be
