Obituary of Sarah Engleman

Sarah C. (Cannell) Engleman, 91, of Leesburg, FL, passed away on January 4, 2017. She was born March 22, 1925 in Cape May, NJ to aspiring poet Humberston Skipwith Cannell of Philadelphia, PA, and Juliette M. Delgrange Cannell of Paris, France. The Cannells started their long journey from France to the United States on the passenger ship, S.S. Republic, and Sarah was born shortly after her parents, and sister May, arrived from France. Sarah enjoyed a 40 year career at Johns Hopkins University, Applied Physics Laboratory in Silver Spring, MD, which culminated into her position as administrative assistant specialist in the office of the Director. Sarah met many of her lifelong friends through her long career with the APL. Sarah was a proud, long-time member, of the Silver Spring Volunteer Fire Department (SSVFD) Auxiliary during David's service as a SSVFD firefighter. Upon retirement, they moved to Orlando, FL, and eventually settled at a retirement community in Leesburg, FL where she enjoyed involvement in many of the

community organizations and clubs. Sarah and David would frequently reflect on their trip of a lifetime which included a visit to Hawaii, followed by a cross-country drive from California to Florida with many sight-seeing stops along the way.
