Obituary of Shirley Sennett

Shirley Hamilton Sennett, 89, of Leesburg, Florida, died Tuesday, November 26, 2013. Born September 1, 1924 in Roscoe, Pennsylvania, she moved to the area in 1960. She was an Army Veteran, 1st Lt. and nurse of the Korean Conflict and member of American Legion Post 347. She was a nurse for 70 years and president of Lake County Medical and Surgical, Inc. She was the newsletter editor of Lake County Ostomy Assoc., charter member of what has become Cornerstone Hospice and was a Gray Lady in public schools for many years. She was a charter member of Christ United Methodist Church, Leesburg.

She is survived by two sons, Jim "Della" Sennett of Louisville, KY, Tim "Margaret" Sennett of Lady Lake, FL; daughter, Lynn Sennett of Leesburg, FL;
