Obituary of Stephan Denton

Stephan Thomas Denton, 68, of The Villages, FL lost his valiant battle to Pancreatic Cancer, November 5, 2010. Mr. Denton was born in Nashville, TN and moved to The Villages in 2007 from Roswell, GA. He was an educator at Roswell High School & retired from the Fulton County School System in 1996. Stephan was a 1960 Graduate of Litton High School, Nashville, TN, a 1964 graduate of the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, a member of D.E.C.A. (Distributive Education Clubs of America). He was a member of the Sigma Nu Fraternity, member of A.V.A. (America Volkssport Association). Steve enjoyed walking, traveling, reading, golf and bunco.
