Mrs. Teresa Lynn Williams went Home unexpectedly in ORMC on 06/06/23 in Orlando, FL. at the age of 63.

Her children remember her as a kind, passionate, loving mother who encouraged them in every ambition and reminded them of God's plan for them.

Teresa was passionate about homemaking and often indulged in cooking, baking, painting, gardening and home remodeling. She was a faith filled individual who loved her Bible and who was gifted at displaying God's hand in her life. As a devout member of the First Baptist Church Okahumpka, she would listen to the sermons online on the days she could not attend in person. She was a loved and admired member of the Leesburg, FL community. To know her is to love her.
