Obituary of THELBERT HARBISON

Thelbert M. Harbison, 89 of Leesburg, Florida and formerly of Altoona, Florida was born May 25, 1924 in Cullman, Alabama and died September 27, 2013. Thelbert was the Postmaster of Altoona for 25 years, retiring in 1982 and a founding member of Grand Island Baptist Church where he served as a deacon and as the church's first Music Director. He was an outdoorsman who enjoyed camping and fishing and was renowned for his fish fries, both at church and home.
