Obituary of Theodore Krawitz

Theodore "Ted" Krawitz, 72, of Leesburg, Florida, died Tuesday, March 22, 2011.

He was born December 8, 1938 in Washington, DC. Ted moved to Leesburg in 2003 from Pembroke Pines, FL. He was active in the North Dade Chamber of Commerce. He was instrumental in getting the Tri-Rail in place and helped facilitate Joe Robbie Stadium. When he moved to Leesburg, he immediately got involved in the Leesburg Area Chamber of Commerce and was still serving on the Board. He was a bowler for 50 years. He worked part time at Disney as a host at Cape May Cafe at Disney's Beach Club Resort.

Ted is survived by his wife, Carole; two daughters, Julie (Mark) Bishop of Clermont, FL, Tracy Calvino of Hollywood, FL and granddaughter, Nicole Morales of Copper City, FL.
