Obituary of Thomas Dorgan

Thomas Aquinas Dorgan Sr., 64, beloved husband, father and grandfather, passed peacefully on Friday, Jan. 27, 2017, at the Lane Purcell Hospice House in Sumterville, FL surrounded by family.
