Obituary of Thomas Stanley

Thomas D. Stanley, 77, of The Villages, FL and a former resident of Leominster, MA, died on Tuesday, June 11, 2013. Mr. Stanley enlisted in the United States Marine Corps after graduation from St. Bernard's High School in 1954. He was a graduate of Fitchburg State College and was a teacher and school administrator at the Bromfield School in Harvard, MA for 30 years. Mr. Stanley was a member of the golfing group, Fraternal Order of the Knights of the Unstable Table and was known as "Tommy Gunn".

He was predeceased by a daughter, Mary Ellen and a son, Timothy.
