Obituary of Tiit Gentalen

Tiit Gentalen, 72, Lady Lake, FL died Friday, August 31, 2012 at the Moffitt Cancer Center, Tampa, Florida. He was born in Tallinn, Estonia and became a US citizen in 1955. His family fled the Soviet occupation of Estonia in 1944 and lived in displaced persons camps in Germany until coming to America in 1949. An avid fisherman, he loved his retirement in Florida and fishing the Harris Chain.

He is survived by his wife of 48 years, Carol Gentalen (Menes), sons Erik (Melissa) and Kirk (Amy), grandsons Leif and Julius, and brother Tom (Linda).

A memorial service will be held Monday, September 10, 2012 at 11:00 a.m. at Hope Lutheran Church, The Villages, with Pastor P. Barry Huntman officiating.
