She strived to showcase the talents of the children under her care, providing encouragement and assistance to foster independence. She made the hard work look easy. My 16 year old granddaughter remembers being in the combined Lake-Sumter Chorus. She was visibly upset and blurted out. "She was the best teacher." when she learned of her death. I am forever indebted to Vanessa for a kindness I had no way of ever repaying. My son struggled in school. Thanks to Vanessa, administering, on her own time, a visograph screening assessment on my son, she was able to pinpoint a physical anomaly that impacted my son's ability to read. His eyes did not track together. As a result of her selfless act, my husband and I contacted a vision specialist who provided much needed therapy for our son. Every time my boy, now 25, excitedly shares information about another book he has enjoyed reading, I praise the Lord for allowing Vanessa to have touched his life.
