### Obituary of Vicky Peters

VICKY WRIGHTSON PETERS, 67, died peacefully Dec. 28 after a lengthy struggle with cancer. She was born in Milwaukee, Wis. Dec. 4, 1947 and grew up in Lyndhurst, Ohio. She graduated from Bowling Green State University in 1968 with a degree in Speech and Hearing Pathology and did graduate studies in Special Education. She taught in the Virginia Beach City Public Schools for nearly 30 years and moved to The Villages in 2009. She was a loyal friend and liked by everyone she met.

She is survived by her husband of 45 years, John E. Peters, son Matthew (Kristi) Peters, of Altamonte Springs, Fla., daughter Rachel (Eric) Frederick, of Stafford, Va., her mother, Ruth M.
