Virgil E. Bliss, aged 89, peacefully passed away at home on Saturday, April 27, 2024. Born in Iola, Kansas on June 25, 1934, Virgil moved to Immokalee, Florida in 1958, where he met the love of his life, Gayle O. McPhail. They were married on February 21, 1959 and moved to Mascotte Florida where he began his career as a Lineman at SECO in Groveland, Florida.
