Obituary of Virginia Berdine

Virginia Louise Evans Berdine, age 95, passed away Friday, February 20, 2015 at Savannah Court of Maitland, Florida. She was fortunate to have her great-niece, Elaine Emerson Maxwell, by her side.

Virginia was born January 1, 1920 in Midway, Florida (near Zolfo Springs) to the late Addison Leonidas Evans Jr. and Emily Gertrude (Simpson) Evans. She worked as a telephone operator and spent much of her free time with her family at her mother's house on Main Street in Leesburg, Florida.
