



Virginia 'Faye' Cutsogeorge

May 30, 1934 - June 3, 2019

Virginia Faye Cutsogeorge (née Richardson) died in her home on 3 June 2019 in The Villages, Florida due to complications following breast cancer. She was 85. Mrs. Cutsogeorge was born on 30 May 1934 in Bonnie Blue, Virginia to her parents, Delos and Ocie Richardson. She married George Cutsogeorge in 23 July 1955. The Cutsogeorges moved to Long Island.
