Vonnie Jackson Morgan Jr., 98, Weirsdale, FL went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, December 11, 2018 with his loving family around him. He was born in Dora, AL to Vonnie and Eula Mae Morgan.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife of 61 years Miriam Hill Morgan, granddaughter Abra Bradford, great granddaughter Danielle Morgan, sister Jenny Dupree and sister Ophilia Brown.

Survivors include son David Morgan (Linda), daughter Nugie Morgan Huey, 3 grandchildren: John Morgan (Donna), Vonnie Morgan (Robin), Morgan Bradford (Amanda), 11 great grandchildren and 4 great great grandchildren.

His teen years were spent in the CCC in Otto, NC. He enlisted in the US Navy at the age of 19, served the duration of WWII and was discharged in 1946. He married Miriam Hill in 1944 in Philadelphia, PA. In 1950, he reenlisted into the Navy during the Korean War and served 2 years in Astoria, OR. After being discharged in 1952, they moved to Leesburg and built and operated the Morgan's Fish Camp and Trailer Park until 1979. He was an avid Alabama football fan, never missing a game. He also loved to mow his own grass, which he did until he died. At the age of 96, he went on the Honor Flight trip to Washington, DC with Gay Harris, who became a great friend.
