Obituary of Waitman Boram

WAITMAN H. BORAM, "Pee Wee" 100, of Lady Lake, Florida, died Friday, September 24, 2010. He was born November 26, 1909 in Buckhannon, West Virginia. He worked for the US Navy as a civilian surveyor. He was a key figure in defense work during WWII for the Federal Government. He worked for PC Gorman and did the dredging for Lake Harris and Lake Griffin. He was a welder; he built the first orange picker. He owned his own sawmill & cut lumber for construction projects.

He was the original owner of Pine Island Fish Camp and owner of Pee Wee's Garage and Repair in Lady Lake, FL.
