### Obituary of Walter Mason

Walter A. Mason, 85, of The Villages, FL died on Friday Sept 10, 2010. He was born in Homestead, PA and lived in West Mifflin, PA working as a carpenter with US Steel in Homestead. He volunteered his time as a leader with the Boy Scouts of America and as a Little League coach. He moved his family to Florida in the mid '60's and worked for 25 years in Real Estate. He was a member of St Timothy Catholic Church, The Villages, FL.

Walter was a World War II combat veteran, landing at Anzio with the 3rd Division. "First Scout" of his Infantry Company, always the first to encounter the enemy, he was awarded the "Bronze Star" for his actions in the campaign to liberate Rome.

He is survived by 3 children, Carey W. Mason, Boynton Bch, FL, Walter Dale Mason, Hallandale, FL, Lynn C. Ferguson, The Villages, 4 grandchildren, and 3 great-grandchildren.
