Comp. where she retired in 1993. She then decided to move to Bushnell, FL February 1994 to be close to her son and where her family lived. Her aunt Elaine moved down with them. She loved holidays but one day she told her children that someone better learn how to cook because she is retiring from all that mess and going to try to enjoy life now that she's retired.

Her daughter and granddaughter moved to Florida also because they were a close family. Just after moving her husband got sick and she was there to care for him until his passing October 21, 1996. She loved to travel, go to the beach, and yard sale until her aunt got sick and Wanda took care of her until she passed May 2004. She had a great relationship with her daughter in law and they spent a lot of time together in her last 20 years.
