Obituary of Warren Maddox

Warren Roscoe Maddox, age 67, of Bushnell, Florida, passed away Sunday, August 24, 2014. Born January 9, 1947 to the late Warren V. and Elizabeth Hubbard Maddox, he was a lifelong resident of Bushnell. Upon graduation from South Sumter High School in 1965 he attended Troy State University where he received a B.S. Degree in 1969. He then served four years in the U.S Air Force, including a tour of Viet Nam. He worked 26 years for the State of Florida, mostly with the Health Department, and was the Sumter County Environmental Health Supervisor for many years. He was a member of the Bushnell City Council since 1999 and also was serving as Vice Mayor. His greatest enjoyment after retirement was traveling with his wife Barbara.
