Weldon Clark Jackson, 74 of The Villages, FL, passed away on Friday, November 13, 2015. He was born in Albany, Texas on August 11, 1941. Graduated high school from Central High in Tulsa, Ok. Attended Tulsa University, Tulsa, Ok. He Joined the Army in 1957. Served in Germany. Discharged in 1960 only to be recalled due to East Berlin wall being erected. Discharged in 1961. He was the first ball player to hit a softball over the fence for a home run at Saddlebrook softball field. dinner with them each week for over 15 years. He enjoyed cruising with special cruising friends, numerus times thru the years. Married wife Gladys in June 27, 1963 in Miami, Oklahoma.
