My three words and details to describe her: "Funny - hilarious, we act silly together, an infectious laugh; Brave - three traumatic brain surgeries, still teaching, I admire her; Loyal - faithful friend for 15 years, we don't see each other often, I can be myself around her."

I loved Wendy dearly and will miss her terribly. She loved her family oh, so much, and I know you are missing her, too.
